

Conservator of Forests for recovery of Forest arrears of Jammu and Srinagar empowered as Collector for certain purposes.

Revenue Department Notification SRO 282 dated 26th May, 1978

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (4) and (5) of section 6 of the Jammu and Kashmir Land Revenue Act, Samvat 1996 and in supersession of notification SRO-407 dated 14th August, 1970, the Government hereby confer upon Conservator of Forests, Kashmir North Circle and Conservator of Forests, Jammu Circle, all the powers of Collector to be exercised by them within the territorial jurisdiction of Kashmir and Jammu Division respectively for recovery of all such sums as are due to the Government and recoverable as arrears of land revenue under section 52 of the Jammu and Kashmir Forest Act, Samvat 1987.

Additional Deputy Commissioner Jammu empowered as Collector in respect of certain cases.

Revenue Department Notification SRO-50 dated 28th January, 1972

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (4) and (5) of section 6 of the Jammu and Kashmir Land Revenue Act, Samvat 1996, the Government hereby confer upon Additional Deputy Commissioner Jammu, all the powers of Collector to be exercised by him within the District of Jammu in respect of such cases as may be transferred to him by the concerned Collector of the District from time to time.

Sales Tax Commissioner and Excise Commissioner Jammu and Kashmir empowered as Divisional Commissioner in certain cases.

Revenue Department Notification SRO 385 dated 23rd August, 1975

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (4) of section 6 of the Jammu and Kashmir Land Revenue Act, Samvat 1996 (XII of 1996), and in supersession of Notification SRO-612 dated 4th September, 1972 the Government hereby confer upon the Sales Tax Commissioner Jammu and Kashmir and the Excise Commissioner Jammu and Kashmir the powers of Divisional Commissioner under the said Act to be exercised by them only in respect of cases arising out of the orders passed by the Deputy Sales Tax Commissioner Jammu and Srinagar and the Deputy Excise Commissioner (Executive) Jammu and Srinagar respectively.

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Excise and Taxation officers (Recovery) Srinagar/Jammu empowered for recovery of tax/sums as land revenue under certain Acts.

Revenue Department ¹Notification SRO-106 dated 3rd March, 1980

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (4) and (5) of section 6 of the Jammu and Kashmir Land Revenue Act, Samvat 1996 (XII of 1996), the Government hereby confer upon the Excise and Taxation Officers, (Recovery) Srinagar/Jammu the powers of Assistant Collector of the first class under the said Act to be exercised by them within their respective jurisdiction in respect of the cases pertaining to recovery of tax/ sums recoverable as arrears of land revenue under the following Acts, namely: -

- i. J&K General Sales Tax, 1962
- ii. J&K Passengers Taxation Act, 1963
- iii. J&K Urban Immovable Property Tax Act, 1962
- iv. J&K Motor Spirit and Diesel Oil (Taxation of Sales) Act, Samvat 2005.

Naib Tehsildars Land Acquisition (Railways) Jammu empowered as Assistant Collector Second Class in respect of certain cases.

Revenue Department ²SRO-747 dated 21st October, 1972

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (4) and (5) of section 6 of the Jammu and Kashmir Land Revenue Act, Samvat 1996, the Government hereby confer upon the Naib Tehsildars Land Acquisition (Railways), Jammu, the powers of Assistant Collector second class to be exercised by them within their respective, jurisdictions in respect of cases relating to attestation of mutations of the land acquired for construction of Railwayline from Kathua to Jammu.

Tehsildars (Nazool) Jammu Srinagar conferred with the powers of Assistant Collector Class I.

Revenue Department ³Notification SRO 110 dated 14th March, 1973

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (4) and (5) of section 6 of the Jammu and Kashmir Land Revenue Act Samvat 1996, the Government hereby confer upon Tehsildars (Nazool) Jammu Srinagar all the powers of Assistant Collector Class I, for purposes of clause (c) of sub-section (2) of section 133 of the said Act, to be exercised by them within their respective jurisdictions in respect of the cases relating to Nazool lands only.

Tehsildars and Naib-Tehsildars (Consolidation) empowered as Assistant Collector of 1st Class and 2nd Class respectively for the work relating to land reforms.

Revenue Department ¹Notification SRO-136 dated 30th March, 1974

In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (4) of section 6 of the Jammu and Kashmir Land Revenue Act, Samvat 1996 (XII of 1996), the Government hereby confer upon all the Tehsildars (Consolidation) and Naib-Tehsildars (Consolidation) the powers of Assistant Collector, of the first class and Assistant Collector of the second class respectively to be exercised by them within their respective jurisdiction for purposes of the work relating to land reforms.

Deputy Sales Tax Commissioner and Deputy Excise Commissioner, Jammu and Srinagar empowered as collectors.

Revenue Department ²Notification SRO-384 dated 23rd August, 1975

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (4) and (5) of section 6 of the Jammu and Kashmir Land Revenue Act, Samvat 1996 (XII of 1996) and in supersession of Notification SRO-816 dated 5th December, 1972, the Government hereby confer upon the Deputy Sales Tax Commissioners Jammu and Srinagar and Deputy Excise Commissioner (Executive) Srinagar and Jammu all the powers of Collector, to be exercised by them within their respective jurisdiction only in respect of cases pertaining to the recovery of sums as arrears under the Acts shown against each in the sub-joined table.

Assistant Commissioner, Land Compensation Rajouri invested with the powers of Collector for certain purposes.

Revenue Department ²Notification SRO-525 dated 1st August, 1972

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (5-a) of section 6 of the Jammu and Kashmir Land Revenue Act, Samvat 1996 and in supersession of Notification SRO-321 dated 29th April, 1972, the Government hereby confer upon the Assistant Commissioner, Land Compensation Rajouri, the powers of a Collector to be exercised by him within the Districts of Poonch and Rajouri in respect of cases pertaining to the rectification of errors as may be transferred to him from time to time by the concerned Collector.

The villages Ghanta, Thalwal of Tehsil Reasi and Mammi of Tehsil Udhampur, shall henceforth be named as Devigarh, Sukhal Ghati and Jadsarkote respectively.

Revenue Department Notification SRO 783 dated 9th Dec. 1976

In exercise of powers conferred by sub-section (4) of section 6 of the Jammu and Kashmir Land Revenue Act, Samvat 1996 (XII of 1996) the Government hereby confer upon all the District Panchayat Officers of the State the powers of the Assistant Collector of the first class under the said Act to be exercised by them within the local limits of their respective District for recovery of the arrears relating to taxes, harat and loans of the C.D. Department as the arrears of land revenue.
