Excise Order No. 122 of 2004 Dated: - 24 -04 -2004.

- Whereas, It has been observed that the bottles of Beer for sale in 18K State do not display "explry date" on the labels.
- 2. Whereas, even after taking due precautions, the shelf life of Beer is best before six months from the date of manufacturing and maximum shelf life is not more than one year.
- 3. Where as consumption of Beer after six months from the date of its manufacturing can be hazardous to the health of the bonafide consumers.
- 4. Now, therefore, in exercise of powers vested in me under section 4-B of J&K Excise Act 1958 and in public interest it is hereby ordered with immediate effect that the following legend shall be printed on all the labels of beer which is either manufactured within the J&K State or imported from outside the J&K State for consumption with in the State of Jammu and Kashmir.
