Notification, Jammu, the <u>18th March</u>, 2005.

.-In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 11, 20 and 25 of the Jammu and Kashmir Excise Act, 1958, the Government hereby direct that in ab-rule (L) of rule 98 of the Jammu and Kashmir Distillery Rules, 1946, for the words commencing from "Before bringing any label" and closing with the words shall carry out the following directions:-"the following shall be substituted.

"Before bringing in label into use the licensee shall submit fifteen exact dpies of labels to the Deputy Excise Commissioner who shall forward them to e Excise Commissioner for his approval. The Excise Commissioner, if he abproves of the label, shall number it and affix his official seal. One copy of each kibel shall be retained in the office of the Commissioner Excise for record and one copy each thereof shall be returned to the Deputy Excise Commissioner, Excise and Taxation Officer and the licensee for information and record. The remaining copies of the labels shall be sent to the Excise ranges and in respect defence to the CSD depots as well. The licensee shall comply with such structions as the Excise Commissioner may issue regarding any label. If the lidensee desires to affix any more labels to the bottles, he shall submit specimens fdr approval in the manner prescribed above. Secondary labels need not have all the details printed on them as required for the main label. In particular the lidensee shall carry out the following directions:-
